#### **President**

- Leads the Club in supporting the School to provide a comprehensive sporting opportunity based on rowing
- Supports the Rowing Manager in development of the Club culture in ensuring all aspects of the Club are functional
- Consults with the Head Coach and Rowing Operations Manager, assists with coaching team recruitment and ensures adequate support for coaches
- Chairs Committee meetings
- Ensures committee roles and functions are filled and carried out
- Negotiates club directions with the Head Coach, Rowing Operations Manager and Committee
- Mediates
- Actively promotes the positive image of the club
- Manages grievances and conflict in accordance with club guidelines
- Constructs annual report and writes President's component

#### **Treasurer**

- Monitors financial information
- Interprets and reports to committee on financial data
- Organises a cash float for fundraising activities
- Prepares an annual report for distribution at the Annual General Meeting
- Consults with the Business Manager and the Rowing Operations Manager on budget strategy

#### Secretary

- Drafts and distributes agendas and provides notice of meetings
- Maintains a register of committee members
- Takes minutes of meeting
- Ensures distribution of minutes
- Follows up on agreed actions from committee meetings
