

Dear Parent/Caregiver

Thank you for your understanding of the difficult events of the last few days.

Unley High School will re-open tomorrow Friday 20 March.

Teachers undertook extensive training today to review and adjust the way we deliver curriculum under the new COVID19 restrictions. This will include information to help students confidently return to school. Some of these changes to meet the guidelines of SA Health include:

- Space between students in classrooms will increase up to 1.5m
- Students will wash their hands before every lesson. New outdoor washing stations have been added and more will be installed in the next few days.
- Hand washing with soap and water for 20 seconds (You may have seen in the media, the time to sing Happy Birthday) is best practice
- The five minute bell before lesson will now be called the handwashing bell
- If a student develops flu like symptoms, parents will be called to pick up their child

Teachers have also been putting lesson activities onto Google Classroom so that students do not miss any work for the last three days. Please have a look at the activities with your child.

Tomorrow and Monday extra support for student wellbeing will be provided by an expanded counselling team to confidentially discuss any concerns.

As I mentioned previously, the school has undergone a thorough professional clean and public health officials have confirmed we are safe to re-open.

Please be aware that due to the disruptions of this week, the canteen has not been able to be restocked and will not be open till Monday. Therefore students will need to bring their lunch on Friday.

We look forward to students returning to school tomorrow.
