

Dear parent/caregiver,

The Communicable Disease Control Branch of SA Health has informed us that a staff member who attends our site has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

This means our school will be shut for a minimum of 24 hours to allow health and education to work together to contact people.

It also allows us to carry out a thorough clean of the entire site.

We will not be opening again until public health officials indicate that it is safe to do so.

Public health and education officials will make contact with people they have identified who need to self-isolate to inform them of the steps they need to take. Anyone told to self-isolate will not be allowed back at school until they have completed the quarantine period specified by health authorities.

If your child is told to self-isolate we will be in touch separately with information on contingencies for their learning while they are away.

When we reopen, anyone who has not been told to self-isolate is able to return to school.

Please be assured that we will be following closely the advice of SA Health and we will be in touch as soon as we can to provide you with more information.
