Dear Parent/Caregiver

Thank you for your support and the email communications parents have sent me this week. It is fantastic that South Australia continues to lead the country with controlling COVID19 and we have now had six days of no new cases. Due to the parent communications I have received coupled with the positive data from SA Health, the direction from the Department for Education and the support of teachers at Unley High School we have decided to resume classroom 'Face to Face' teaching as from **Monday 4<sup>th</sup> of May**.

This does mean the end of Online Learning in its current form as it is not feasible to provide both methods of delivery at the same time. We do recognise that some parents are managing complex health situations and may decide to keep students home a little longer. To support this situation, students will be able to work independently from home but not with the comprehensive online direction teachers have provided this week or last term. Teachers will continue to share assignments and resources via Google Classroom and Daymap for students to access independently.

Therefore, the following survey asks you to nominate whether your student/s are returning to school for classroom learning or continue working from home during the COVID19 pandemic.
