



Dear parent/caregiver

With the small numbers of students attending at the end of Term 1 it was not possible to distribute our school photos through home groups. We are able to store photos and delay collection until schooling has returned to normal. We will also make photos available for collection during week 2 of the school holidays (20-24 April) according to the schedule below. Please ensure that you know the home group number for each of your students to allow us to quickly find your photos. To ensure social distancing we will distribute photos from the front double door entrance to the STEM centre. If a queue forms, we ask that you line up with 1.5 metres distance between each person.

If you have multiple photo packs you are able to pick these up in a single visit. Family/group photo packs are with the eldest student in your family. If photos have not been paid for, a "bookmark" with a link to online payment is available for each student / group photo.

Photos were printed prior to Friday 3rd April, and have only been handled with gloves since delivery at Unley High School, with last handling prior to photo collection on Tuesday 7 April. Envelopes have not been opened. After collecting your envelope, please remove photos and dispose of the envelope in general waste, then wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Staff will use gloves to handle photos at the time of distribution. Social distancing of 1.5 metres must be complied with. We request that parents not enter the school buildings when collecting photos.
