Please note this is a commitment for the first four weeks of Term 2.

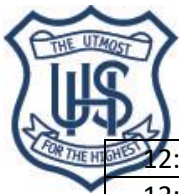
Unley High School Online Learning

Following is a brief outline of the expectations for online learning. These expectations are the minimum requirements only as subject teachers will set the program for the week based upon the assignment types and the unique nature of their subject. Thank you again for parent feedback last term that has helped us shape our online delivery.

1. Attendance Term 2: Daymap will reflect students at school will be marked with the SB code for school-based learning and students studying at home will be marked with H for home learning. (Illness codes will still apply and parents simply contact Student Services as usual).
2. A common starting point for all students: At the start of each week, teachers will publish a brief weekly schedule in Google Classroom. This will support students and parents to know what is expected for the week and know where to start.
3. Students will follow the regular timetable. This is when they are to work on their lesson activities and make contact with their subject teacher as required. We encourage students to take breaks at Recess and Lunchtime to have a rest from screen time.

4. Live contact: Students must have at least one *live* contact per week with their subject teacher. This may vary for year levels and subjects. This contact could be via:
 - Video conference – Zoom, Meet etc.
 - Chat – Google Classroom, Hangouts etc.
5. Online Learning Tracking: Each Wednesday afternoon we will identify students who have not connected with their subject teacher in the past 5 days. Year Level Managers will follow up via email with both students and parents.
6. Tracking submission of tasks: Subject teachers will follow up non-submission of assignments and missed deadlines via parent email. Missing deadlines without the usual face-to-face nudging of the teacher is one of our concerns, so parent assistance to ensure deadlines are met, is appreciated.

I have also attached the letter for students to help them to understand how to conduct online learning.

Thank you in anticipation of completing the attendance survey. I will continue to keep families updated each week.
