Term 1 Report Summary:

It is a live page which displays grades as they are published. You may look at the page anytime but please be aware that teachers have until next Thursday to complete their Term 1 Grades.

Daymap has only just finished creating this page so we will continue to customise it over the next few weeks. The title of this section will become "Educational Progress Report" and the "Results" tab will change to "Progress".

Attendance Marking in Term 2:

Attendance will be marked daily in Daymap. Students studying from home will be marked **H** and students at school will be marked **SB.** If any student is unable to access online classes either form home or from school due to illness, please contact Student Services or submit an absence via the School Stream app and the attendance code will be updated appropriately (i.e I for illness).

Tracking Participation in online learning in Term 2:

Our trial this week has helped us to develop an attendance record system separate from Daymap which we will employ from Week 2 next term. Year Level Managers will be following up students and communicating with parents.
