NOMINATION CRITERIA:

Academic Excellence

The award of Academic Excellence is presented to (full-time) students who received the grade 'A' in all their subjects in their Semester 1 report and have maintained these grades in their Semester 2 summative tasks up to Week 3 in Semester 2.

Academic Growth Award

The Academic Growth Award is presented to the top ten students in each year level who have shown the highest GPA growth over the year and have strived to achieve to the very best of their abilities but did not receive an Academic Excellence Award.

School Service Awards

These students have demonstrated ***exceptional and sustained*** service to the school for the benefit of the whole school community including but not limited to School Sport, Student Voice and The Arts.

Outstanding Student 7-11 Award

This award is given to a student in each year level who has demonstrated consistent academic achievement combined with contribution to the school community.

COMMUNITY SPONSORED AWARDS:

ADF Long Tan Award - This award acknowledges young people who have demonstrated outstanding qualities of leadership and teamwork within the school and the wider community

ADF Future Innovators STEM Award - This award recognises the recipients' Maths and Science abilities whilst highlighting their motivation and innovation in the area and displaying strong ethical values.

Zealand Cup - The Zealand Cup was donated by the Zealand family in 1983. This award recognizes two middle school students who have shown outstanding sportsmanship and ability in their varied and extensive contribution to the school sports program, over grade 7, 8 and 9.
